

## MINOR IN COMMUNICATION STUDIES

The minor in Communication Studies consists of 18 credit hours of COMM studies classes, including, COMM 1101 (Public Speaking), COMM 2100 (Communication Theory), and 12 credits of electives with at least 6 credit hours taken at the 3000/4000 level. Students must attain an overall GPA of 2.0 within all minor coursework.

**Requirements to Declare:** Students matriculated at UNC Charlotte and planning to declare Communication Studies as their minor must have an **overall GPA of at least 2.0**
